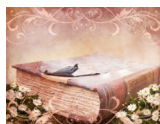

CHURCH COVENANT

Elder: By what common and gracious experiences do we enter into spiritual fellowship and covenant relations with God and with one another?

PEOPLE: Having been led, as we believe, by the Spirit of God, to receive the Lord Jesus Christ as our Saviour, and on the profession of our faith, having been baptized in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost, we do now in the presence of God, angels, and this assembly, most solemnly and joyfully enter into covenant with one another, as one body in Christ.

Elder: What vows do we gladly make as stewards of that which God has entrusted to us?

PEOPLE: To contribute cheerfully and regularly to the support of the ministry, the expenses of the Church, the relief of the poor, and the spread of the Gospel throughout all nations.

Elder: For the sake of our homes and our loved ones, what gracious tasks do we humbly assume?

Elder: Since one is our Master, even Christ, and we all are brethren, in what ways are we to strengthen each other and adorn the teachings of our Lord and Saviour?

PEOPLE: We further commit to watch over one another in brotherly love; to remember each other in prayer; to aid each other in sickness and distress; to cultivate Christian sympathy in feeling and courtesy in speech; to be slow to take offense, but always ready for reconciliation, and mindful of the rules of our Saviour to seek it without delay.
